Bharat Shikshan Prasarak Mandal was established in the year 1953. It was founded to facilitate the educational needs of Wadala village and surrounding area. During 1590 educational facilities were centered in and around cities. In rural areas only primary education was available at some places, and Wadala was no exception to it. So Bharat Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, Wadala was established on 14th April 1953 to make available secondary education in rural areas. This 'Sanstha' started a high school named 'New High-School' in June 1953.

The visionary people like Mr. Ravaji Devrao Sathe decided to have educational unit to serve the educational needs of the village and surroundings. They had not enough resources to start an educational unit therefore they appealed villagers to help economically and villagers also responded positively. In response Dattatraya Govind Garad donated 6 Acres of land to the 'Sanstha' Initially the classes were held in 'Maruti' temple. The temple was not enough to the growing number of classes so Shri Gangaram Dhawan donated 14 Acres of land to the 'Sanstha' on this land the 'Sanstha' built 20 classrooms and along with this they started 'Jai Bharat' Hostel for the students coming from neighboring villages of Wadala. In this way our 'Sanstha' made a modest beginning in 1950.

The real development of the 'Sanstha' started from 1973 onwards when a visionary person Honorable Baliram (Kaka) Sathe took over reins of 'Sanstha' in his hand.

To train the excellent quality teachers 'Mauli Adhyapak Vidhyalaya',(D.T.Ed) was established in 1990. Kakaji noticed that after passing 10th standard with good marks students particularly girls were forced to stop their education as there was no facility of higher secondary education so he started junior college in 1990.

There was no looking back Kakasaheb understood the importance of higher education for the development of rural society, so he started 'Mauli Mahavidyalaya in the year 2000 to spread higher education in rural areas. As stated above Kakasaheb has a vision and sympathy for the society, so he decided to start a unit for the boys who are mentally abnormal and he started 'Mauli Matimand Nivasi Vidyalaya' in 2003 – 04 and after that in 2007 – 08 'Sanstha' started 'Mauli College of Education (B.Ed) and in 2007 – 08 M.Ed college to serve the regional needs.

In this way 'Sanstha' started many units but 'Mauli Mahavidyalaya' is a unit which imparts the higher education to 400 plus students. The college has got well qualified staff to impart the quality education. The college has just completed 10 years and is getting ready to be assessed by NAAC.

The 'Sanstha' has also constructed well equipped girls hostel named 'Late Shevantabai Shinde' having 100 plus occupancy with 32 rooms.

Today 'Bharat Shikshan Prasarak Mandal' runs 08 educational institutions in a small village like Wadala. We do feel proud to tell you that almost 2200 plus students are being benefitted from all these educational institutions. There are almost 90 teachers engaged in the noble cause of imparting knowledge to those students. A total of 65 non teaching are also engaged in smooth conduct of all these institutions.
